Since 2007, ADCAM (Association for Development, Alternative Trade and Microcredit) has been carrying out an exciting project in the heart of the Kenyan savannah, in collaboration with www.sawamara.com. This dream that became true supports the Masai people with a nursery and primary school that has already changed the lives of more than 250 children.

In this corner of the world, school is not just a place of learning, it is a door to the future. Thanks to effort and dedication, we have created a space full of opportunities:

- Classrooms equipped to make learning a real pleasure.
- Computer classes and laboratory, because knowledge has no limits.
- A school library, where each book opens up a new world.

- Kitchen and dining room, so that every child grows healthy and strong.
- Residences for students who live far away, because no dream is too far away.
- o Housing for teachers, ensuring that education heroes are always close by.
- Solar energy to power a computer room and much more.
- A well for drinking water, essential for health and hygiene.
- A community vegetable garden that feeds bodies and hearts.

EDUCATION THAT INSPIRES AND TRANSFORMS

Our educational proposal follows the guidelines of the Kenyan Education Ministry, but goes further, including subjects as valuable as Masai Culture. This allows students to reconnect with their roots, feel proud of who they are and counteract the loss of identity that has affected their community in recent decades.

According to the Indigenous People Rights declaration approved in 2007 by the UN, the Masai are one of the 31 most endangered tribes on the planet. Therefore, we work to preserve their identity and open new opportunities for their future.

Our school also stands out in other fundamental aspects:

- We promote respect for the environment.
- We encourage active parents and the community active participation in school life.
- We offer extracurricular activities that enrich the student comprehensive education.
- We provide solid training in computer science, positioning our school as a benchmark in the area.
- In addition, we take care of our students' well-being with a daily lunch that ensures adequate nutrition for their development. At the beginning of each academic year, each student receives two uniforms, books and all the necessary school supplies so that nothing stops them from learning.





BUILDING A BETTER WORLD TOGETHER

Our school has been made possible thanks to the generosity of companies, organisations and individuals who have put their trust in this project. Their contributions have not only allowed us to build it, but also to cover the essential operating and maintenance costs, such as team salaries, school materials, uniforms, books, food and repairs.

To encourage the responsibility of Masai families, those in a less vulnerable situation, have begun to contribute a small quarterly fee. However, this income is far from covering the real cost of keeping the school running.

We know that not all families can afford this contribution, and that is why, at ADCAM, we have awarded scholarships to the most vulnerable students. They are the reason for our daily effort and the driving force that gives meaning to our work.

To ensure the sustainability of this educational project, we have launched the "School Support" system, a periodic donation initiative that covers the cost of schooling for a Maasai boy or girl. This collaboration allows us to continue developing our work and providing these children with a quality education that transforms lives.

At ADCAM we offer two types of collaboration for those who wish to make a difference in the Masai children lives:

BASIC SUPPORT


